

Request for Proposals

Introduction

Mitchell County Economic Development Commission Inc. is a 501 (c)(3) nonprofit organization supported by private and public funding that is charged with accelerating economic growth in Mitchell County. Mitchell County EDC works with industry leaders, site selection consultants, government agencies and other entities to facilitate expansion and development strategies for existing businesses and recruit target industries to Mitchell County. Mitchell County EDC is requesting qualified submissions for proposed development options of a 90+/- acre property commonly referred to as the Mitchell Business Park.

Mitchell County EDC issued this Request for Proposals (RFP) for various professional services from full-service, consulting engineering firms. The proposals submitted should include detailed costs of the following areas for Business Park Master Planning and Development Options and Geotechnical Services:

- Business Park Master Planning to maximize roughly 90 acres that make up the Mitchell Business Park site. Various development scenarios should be included to both maximize the site available given existing restrictions but also include a campus-type development option.
- 2. Geotechnical analysis performed to meet the NC Certified Sites standards and to ensure the consulting engineer has confidence in the resulting site plan development options and cost estimates. Mitchell County EDC will make available to the selected firm due diligence formerly done including Phase 1, limited geotechnical, wetlands determination, cultural resources review, and endangered species review.
- 3. Proposed development scenarios should reflect target industrial sectors for Mitchell County including automotive, aerospace, life science, assembly, agriculture science, food science, additive manufacturing, and data centers.
- 4. Site plans and development scenarios for the land site that includes pad layouts detailing grading costs per building option along with infrastructure costs.
- 5. Planning and development costs for rail extension only.
- 6. Completed project, including narrative, spreadsheets, blueprints, etc. should be provided in both printed and digital formats.

Response Requirements

Responding firms must include the following:

- Cover letter
- Detailed costs of services for requested development options and planning services as described above
- Project Team/Subconsultants and Organizational Chart
- Experience for key project Team Members
- At least three (3) examples of past project profile sheets of comparable sites with client reference contact information for those examples
- Prior experience with NC Commerce Certified Sites, EDPNC Select Sites, and the Golden LEAF SITE program
- Proposals must state they are valid for 90 days from the date of submission
- Certificate of Insurance
- Legal name and corporate status of RFP respondent

Evaluation Criteria

Costs associated with providing the above services will be a major factor for awarding this RFP although experience with the special development and geological characteristics of Mitchell County, NC, will be considered. Respondents who can provide relative confidence in the projected costs of the different development scenarios based on experience will be evaluated. Other factors

Mitchell County EDC, at its sole discretion, deems relevant to the responding firm's ability to perform the requested services as outlined in this RFP.

Mitchell County EDC reserves the right to reject any and all responses submitted and to void this RFP process without notice. Any and all RFP elements, requirements and schedules are subject to change and modification.
